President's Message





Somehow, this year I find myself working for my former employees, a lifetime member of MVMA and the new MVMA President.

Time flies, and things happen that one cannot foresee. My veterinary career started with graduation from the College of Veterinary

Medicine at the University of Minnesota in 1981. Within days after graduation, I started a practice with a classmate, Dr. Kevin Nigon, just outside of Rochester, Minnesota. Kevin was a native of the area and an opportunity had arisen in the area. That practice became Northern Valley Animal Clinic, a small animal practice in Rochester in which I am still a partner. The practice started as a mixed practice, but after some time we split the business operationally into two entities, our small animal clinic in Rochester, and a food animal practice, Northern Valley Dairy Production Medicine Center in nearby Plainview, Minnesota.

For most of my career, my daily focus has been bovine, mostly dairy medicine. However, as a small animal practice owner, I have kept interest and understanding in the challenges and opportunities in small animal practice as well. Not long ago my partners and I sold Northern Valley Dairy Production Medicine Center to two of our employees. The name of the practice is now Northern Valley Livestock Services. I am employed at the practice full time as a consultant in dairy production medicine.

Why MVMA President? Why now? I asked myself those questions when I was recruited to run for the position. The most important answer was to give something back to MVMA. While I have been a lifetime member and have served on at least one committee for almost all of those 40 years, I do not feel that I have done nearly as much for MVMA as MVMA has done for me. Instead, I have mostly taken MVMA's efforts to help me succeed professionally for granted.

Much of what MVMA does operates in the background of one's professional life, much like the operating system of your computer. As long as most features function appropriately, we do not intervene.

Yet we need that operating system, and someone needs to oversee and maintain it. It is not just going to keep working on its own.

The second answer is that I suppose, or I hope, that I have some wisdom from my experiences that might be of advantage to MVMA. Hopefully that wisdom outweighs the lack of youthful exuberance. For one, I think what we do as veterinarians has become much more diverse, and few of us have extensive experience in more than a few pieces of that diversity. For example, small animal medicine and surgery have continued to become more sophisticated, and pet owners' expectations regarding those capabilities have become much greater. In dairy practice the same is true. While individual dairy cattle medicine has probably become less complicated because the value of a cow in real dollars had dramatically declined, what I call dairy enterprise medicine has become much more complicated. Enterprise medicine means that practitioners work for the health of the enterprise. This means understanding records, human resource management, food safety, public health, environmental health, markets, and so much more. Likewise, client expectations have ratcheted up.

Because of the diversity of what we do, conflicts may sometimes arise between the various parts of our profession. The views of a shelter veterinarian, a lab animal veterinarian, a poultry veterinarian, a companion animal practitioner, a zoo veterinarian and a racetrack veterinarian probably differ on a lot of animal-related topics, for example. However, even though we may operate in vastly different practices we all share more than we do not share. Indeed, the diversity of what we do is our strength. We all recite the same veterinarian's oath. We all speak the same language. It is the language of the animal kingdom. No other group understands animals, of any species, the way we do. It is who we are and what we do. That gift of understanding binds us together and will continue to do so in the future.

I am looking forward to serving you as the MVMA President for these next twelve months.

MVMA BOARD OF DIRECTORS

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MVMA CAPITOL REPORT: UNPRECEDENTED PACE

The 2023 legislative session is moving at an unprecedented pace. Nearly 1,600 bills have been introduced in the House and over 1,500 in the Senate in the first six weeks of session. The legislature has already passed and the Governor has signed into law major legislation on abortion, a 100% clean energy by 2040, the Crown Act, and tax conformity. Other major proposals including the marijuana legalization, paid family and medical leave, sick and safe time, and election law changes have had multiple hearings and are moving towards floor votes in the coming weeks.

BUDGET PROPOSAL LOOMS LARGE

Governor Walz announced a \$65.2 billion dollar budget proposal, which would be the largest budget in the state's history. Additionally, he has proposed a \$3.3 billion dollar bonding bill, which would also be one of the largest in history. The next budget forecast is scheduled to be released at the end of February. These are the forecast numbers the legislature will use to set their two year budget. The legislature has set the three legislative deadlines for Friday, March 10th, Friday, March 24th and Tuesday, April 4th. All policy and budget related bills must be heard and passed to the floors of either body, or be residing on of the two finance committees by these dates.

ACTION NEEDED FROM MVMA MEMBERS

MVMA members, staff, and our lobbyists continue to advance legislation to provide a pathway for voluntary licensure of veterinary technicians. Bills were recently introduced in the House and Senate. HF1228 authored by Representative John Huot (DFL - Rosemount) and SF1522 authored by Senator Rob Kupec (DFL - Moorhead). Good progress is being made this year and we encourage all of our members to call or email your legislators and ask them to support this important legislation. You can easily find your legislators information and send them an email by going to https://bit.ly/mvmaaction.

We also continue to monitor and oppose the efforts to create a new companion animal board. HF1168 authored by Representative Mike Freiberg (DFL - Golden Valley) and SF1136 authored by Senator Scott Dibble (DFL - Minneapolis) were introduced recently. We have been meeting with legislators to educate them on the harm this legislation can cause to our existing Board of Animal Health. As an alternative and to address some of the concerns of those pushing for a new companion animal board, we are supporting efforts to create a new office of animal protection. This bill, SF1411, is being authored by Sen. Bobby Jo Champion, Minneapolis and would promote programs to protect the welfare of animals, educate the public on animal welfare and work with law enforcement and other state and federal government agencies to protect the welfare of animals.

Veterinary Day at the Capitol is scheduled for Wednesday, March 8. We will return to the Capitol given that in-person operations have resumed. For the 2023 Legislative Session, over one-quarter of the members of the legislature will be first-time legislators. It is critical for us to continue to build upon the relationships we have and to foster new ones as we advocate for our priorities. Thank you to all who registered to join us.

MVMA Membership Updates

After thoughtful discussion, with the intention of making the membership types and descriptions more clear, the Board approved the below updated Membership names and descriptions at the December 9th, 2022 Board Meeting.

What does this mean for you as a member? After March 1st, 2023 the MVMA website will be updated with the new language! See below for the updates.

Active Member (\$295, new member prorated pricing Nov-May)

- Any graduate of a recognized veterinary college who is of good moral character, and reputable professional methods
- Practitioners shall be licensed in the area in which they practice
- If the candidate is favorably approved by the MVMA Board of Directors, they will become an Active Member
- Active Members may hold elective office, and vote
 - Alternate membership option: Academic

Non-DVM Veterinary Professional Member (formerly Affiliate)

(\$115, new member prorated pricing Nov-May)

- Any non-DVM professionals, animal science or research teachers, faculty, Practice Managers, Veterinary Technicians, etc.
- If the candidate is favorably approved by the MVMA Board of Directors, they will become a Non-DVM Veterinary Professional Member
- Non-DVM Veterinary Professional Members may not hold elective office, vote on any matter, nor have any right or title to or interest in any real or personal property of the Association

Academic Member (\$200, prorated pricing Nov-May)

- Any DVM (Veterinarian) working in a college, university of academic veterinary technician program setting
- If the candidate is favorably approved by the MVMA Board of Directors, they will become an Academic Member
- Academic Members may not hold elective office, vote on any matter, nor have any right or title to or interest in any real or personal property of the Association
 - o Alternate membership option: Active

Out of State Member (formerly Associate)

(\$130, new member prorated pricing Nov-May)

- Any DVM (Veterinarian) who meets the qualifications of Active Membership but who resides and practices outside of the State of Minnesota
- If the candidate is favorably approved by the MVMA Board of Directors, they will become an Out of State Member
- Out of State Members may not hold elective office, vote on any matter, nor have any right or title to or interest in any real or personal property of the Association
 - o Alternate membership option: Active

Supporting Member (\$390, new member prorated pricing Nov-May)

- Any business individual, partnership, corporation, or other business entity, who desires to support the purpose of the Association
- Eligible to receive the Association's publications and participate in programs as the MVMA Board of Directors permits
- Supporting Members may be a part of the Industry Partners Committee, which helps veterinarians feel supported by the industry, by offering products and services for the benefit of veterinary practices.
- If the candidate is favorably approved by the MVMA Board of Directors, they will become a Supporting Member
- Supporting Members may not hold elective office, vote on any matter, nor have any right or title to or interest in any real or personal property of the Association, or serve on an non-industry committees
- Special dues assessments may not be levied against Supporting Members

Graduate Student/Intern/Resident Member

(\$100, new member prorated pricing Nov-May)

- Any DVM (Veterinarian) currently enrolled in a graduate veterinary program from an accredited college of veterinary medicine or employed as an intern, fellow or resident at an accredited institution or facility
- If the candidate is favorably approved by the MVMA Board of Directions, they will become a Graduate Student/Intern/Resident Member
- Graduate Student/Intern/ Resident Members may not hold elective office, vote on any matter, nor have any right or title to or interest in any real or personal property of the Association

Recent Graduate Member (formerly Graduate Practicing)

(\$165, new member prorated Nov-May)

- Any DVM practicing in their 1st, 2nd, 3rd of 4th year after graduation from an accredited college of veterinary medicine or immediately following completion of graduate, intern, fellowship or residency work.
- Practitioners shall be licensed in the area in which they practice
- If the candidate is favorably approved by the MVMA Board of Directors, they will become a Recent Graduate Member
- These members shall have the same rights as Active Members

Student Member (\$25)

- Any full-time veterinary student of an accredited veterinary college.
- If the candidate is favorably approved by the MVMA Board of Directors, they shall become a Student Member
- Student Members May not hold elective office, vote on any matter, nor have any right or title to or interest in any real or personal property of the Association

Life Member

- Any current Active member who has been in good standing as an Active MVMA Member for a total of 40 years from the date of obtaining their Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree
- If the candidate is favorably approved by the MVMA Board of directors, they shall become a Life Member
- Life Members shall receive all of the privileges of Active Members, except they shall not pay dues after attaining Life Member status.

Non-Practicing DVM Member (formerly Inactive Member) (\$165)

- This membership status is upon request and approved by the MVMA Board of Directors
- Any Active Member who is not currently practicing veterinary medicine shall become a Non-Practicing DVM member, this includes retired DVM's who are not yet eligible for Life Membership
- Non-Practicing DVM Members may not hold elected office, vote on any matter, nor have any right or title to or interest in any real or personal property of the Association
- Non-Practicing DVM members are not eligible for Life Membership
- Special dues assessments may not be levied against Non-Practicing DVM members



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MVMA Annual Meeting Awards

The Minnesota Veterinary Medical Association presented the MVMA Awards at the Business Meeting in February 2023. The awards were given to individuals in the various MVMA award categories.

Veterinarian of the Year - Dr. Roger Madison

This award is given to an MVMA member who has given much to the veterinary profession as well as to their community - a well rounded member who is outstanding in the profession.



Dr. Roger Madison is a Lifetime member of the MVMA, a regular volunteer at the Miracle of Birth Center, attends the MVMF Golf Classic on a regular basis and was an AVMA Alternate Delegate for 8 years. His story inspired us all with his dedication to Anderson Veterinary Service and his community.

Even at the age of 80-years-old, Dr. Madison helps Anderson Veterinary Service every Monday and Tuesday with large animal emergencies and sick calls. This past summer, he stepped up when the area needed it most. His nomination stated: "Normally a 6 full-time doctor practice, Anderson Veterinary Service was down to 4 full-time doctors for two months. Dr. Madison was called upon to work a lot more than his normal two mornings per week. We are honestly not

sure what we would have done without him. At a time when burnout and stress are so prevalent in veterinary medicine, having Dr. Madison allowed time for the other doctors to take a well-deserved day off here and there for a family vacation or to attend a family event."

Outstanding Industry Representative - Ms. Maria O'Connor Vetscher

Outstanding Industry Representative-Individuals who have consistently exhibited outstanding service to veterinarians and/or the MVMA and have promoted the profession through liaisons with the MVMA, veterinarians, and the profession in general.



Ms. Maria O'Connor Vetscher has been working in the Veterinary Industry for 20 years. She graduated from the University of Minnesota with a B.S. in Biology and later graduated from NDSU with a B.S. in Veterinary Technology. Outstanding Faculty Award - Dr. Lindsay Merkel

This award is given to a faculty member of the University of Minnesota College of Veterinary Medicine and all its related departments; who provide outstanding service to Minnesota veterinarians; who give of their time and talent to the veterinary profession; a leader who makes a difference to the profession; a dedicated contributor to organized veterinary medicine.



Dr. Lindsay Merkel is an associate professor at the University of Minnesota CVM and Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine-Small Animal Internal Medicine. She completed her Medicine residency at the U of MN before taking a faculty position there in 1994. She is passionate about all things Internal Medicine, but particularly loves endocrine and renal diseases.

Dr. Merkel loves teaching in the clinics, seeing patients, and mentoring students, interns, and residents. She loves working with faculty, house officers, and the primary veterinary community to integrate care for patients, both in and out of the VMC. Dr. Merkel is also very passionate about the well-being and mental health of veterinary health care teams

introducing the Purple Chair project with two of her valued technicians, working on the Orange Frog initiative with Drs, Churchill and Motschenbacher and Flannery Miley, and speaking on the subject with Dr. Megan Schommer on KARE11's Breaking the News with Jana Shortall.

Distinguished Veterinary Service Award - Ms. Kim Horne

Awarded to MVMA members, non-member veterinarians or non-veterinarians who have performed outstanding service to the veterinary profession and have contributed to the well-being of animals.



Ms. Kim Horne graduated from the University of Minnesota, Technical College of Waseca. After working in a few private practices, she joined the University of Minnesota VMC and found her career passion in Dermatology.

Although she has recently retired, Ms. Horne is still active in her state association (MAVT) and is a Charter Member and Co-Founder of the Academy of Dermatology Veterinary Technicians (ADVT). She was ADVT's first President and is currently serving as Secretary and Exam Committee Chair. She has lectured Internationally and authored journal articles as well as being co-editor of the Small Animal Dermatology for Technicians and Nurses book.

She has spent countless hours working on educating the veterinary community on the benefits and need to license veterinary technicians. She has traveled across the state presenting on it to the

profession and to legislators as an advocate and voice for veterinary technicians.

Dr. Peterson leaned on Dr. Sillerud's knowledge, leadership and unwavering support throughout her time as MVMA President this past year.

MVMA Animal Hall of Fame

To celebrate and recognize the important link between animals and humans, the MVMA awarded three exceptional animals at the 2023 Annual Meeting.

Companion Animal of the Year - Eddi (Owner, Wayne Halverson)

This award goes to animals who have provided a benefit to their human companions or their community.



Over the last 5 years, Eddi and Wayne volunteered MANY hours providing animal therapy with North Star Therapy Animals, the University of Minnesota PAWs Program, and MSP Animal Ambassadors. Eddi was the perfect therapy dog and would greet everyone with a quiet tail wag and calm demeanor. Eddi provided love, stress reduction, companionship and overall joy to his owners as well as countless students, travelers, MSP airport staff, faculty and staff at the Veterinary Medical Center.

His most important role came over the last 2 years as one of his family members has dealt with medical issues. He provided unconditional love, support, and stress reduction during the numerous medical appointments, procedures,

and healing. Unfortunately, Eddi had a rough spring and his owners made the very compassionate decision to say goodbye in May 2022. His legacy lives on as Wayne has continued volunteer work with these programs.

Professional Animal of the Year - Oscar (Owner, Corey Dawson)

This award goes to animals specially trained to assist humans.



Oscar is a service dog that supports his handler, Corey Dawson, who suffers from PTSD and complications from a TBI.

Oscar made the process of going back to school easier for Corey as helped alleviate some of the symptoms of his disability. Corey credits Oscar with helping him graduate and has now became an unofficial therapy dog to his coworkers.

"He is attentive to others and helps them to destress," his nomination by Mr. Dawson stated. "Being a service dog Oscar is trained to put my needs first. That means if I am in all-day meetings or have a late night of classes he is right

there with me. Part of his job is to wake me up from nightmares and for the first couple of months we were together he would be up most of the night watching me...I owe him a lot. I would have never had the courage to change jobs if not for him."

MVMA Animal Hall of Fame

Hero Animal of the Year - Bronson (Owner, Cole Davies)

This award goes to animals who have saved or preserved human life.



Bronson was paired with Cole Davies as a Seizure Assist Dog when Cole was in his late teens. Never leaving his side, Bronson is happy to take on the role of persistent supervisor. If Cole falls suddenly, Bronson rushes to a family member to alert them and then leads them to Cole. Bronson then retrieves a bag of supplies that help Cole get through his seizure safely. If Cole is lying on his back, Bronson uses his nose to nudge Cole's shoulder off the ground and then "visits" by placing his head over Cole's arm, keeping his one side propped slightly off the ground.

If Cole seizes while sleeping, Bronson responds to his movements by tugging open his door and rushing to alert a

family member, then going downstairs to grab the bag and pull it all the way back up. In an exceptional moment of need, Cole had a seizure while walking outside by himself. No one saw or heard anything, and if it hadn't been for Bronson staying by his side and vocalizing his distress, Cole would not have gotten the care he required. Cole sustained injuries from hitting the pavement, but Bronson is a hero by responding with his intuitive skills and simultaneously notifying neighbors. Cole credits Bronson with saving his life.

Q&A: Meet Your President James Bennett, DVM



WHAT INSPIRED YOU TO PURSUE A CAREER IN VETERINARY MEDICINE?

I was a rural Minnesota farm kid. Growing up with a menagerie of animals including cattle, swine, sheep, dogs, cats, ducks, geese, and chickens made me appreciate the importance and complexity of animal life.

WHERE DID YOU STUDY?

Undergraduate at St. John's University, Collegeville, MN, DVM from University of Minnesota

WHAT DO YOU ENJOY MOST ABOUT YOUR JOB?

For really all of my career my personal focus has been production animal medicine. By production animal medicine I mean everything associated with helping folks who rely on their animals for their livelihoods succeed. The most enjoyable thing is just watching them and helping them do just that.

WHEN NOT WORKING, WHAT CAN YOU BE FOUND DOING?

When not working I might be watching a show in Spanish on Netflix, since I started getting serious about learning that language at the beginning of the Covid – 19 outbreak, or, if it is winter I might be Nordic

skiing. I acquired an interest in skiing marathons when I was in veterinary school, when some school friends started talking about skiing "that Birkebeiner thing". I have finished every one, except one, since graduation, as well as a whole bunch of other races. In summer I might be found running through the woods on a trail for fun, or during a race, or maybe in a canoe.

WHAT IS A VALUABLE LESSON YOU HAVE LEARNED IN YOUR CAREER?

A long career can teach so many valuable lessons, but I think the most valuable deal with people and how one treats people. I often tell my dairy producer clients that "cows are easy; people are hard", meaning that people are complex and have a whole world of different experiences, outlooks and motivations. Treating people with respect, dignity, and kindness can be difficult at times in part because of their complexity, but in the end it always pays dividends.

WHAT IS THE BEST PIECE OF ADVICE YOU EVER RECEIVED?

"Remember, you need your clients more than your clients need you." That is a direct quote from Dr. Phil Berends, St. Charles, MN.

HOW DID YOU GET INVOLVED WITH THE MVMA?

My recollection is that I joined MVMA during or right after veterinary school. However, that was 42 years ago, and I will become a life (40 year) member this year, so I must be mistaken. Anyway, I joined early, and probably joined a committee within the next year or two or three. I believe I have been on at least one committee every year since then.

WHY WOULD YOU RECOMMEND THAT SOMEONE JOIN MVMA?

I recommend that everyone read the MVMA Mission Statement, and MVMA Strategic Goals which can be found by going to mvma.org/mission-history.

Being an MVMA member helps one achieve professional and personal success, and also enhances animal well-being and public health. Of course, one can do all of this without the MVMA, but the MVMA can help provide structure and a framework to those ends.

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LET'S TALK MENTAL HEALTH: MANAGING ANXIETY CAUSED BY LIFE TRANSITIONS

As we enter into the last phases of winter, and prepare for all that spring has to offer, I find myself reflecting on how powerful transitions are and how often these spaces can be spaces of anxiety and fear.

Change and transitions are often a polarizing topic. There are a whole number of people who say they enjoy change and feel as though they ride through it well. There is another part of the population that is as close to avoidant as possible when it comes to change.

Ultimately, what science and research says is that most humans can manage some level of change when they feel as though they have at least some autonomy and independence within the change. More generally, if we feel as though we are in control with the change than most of us can ride through it. However, when we don't feel as though we are in control, we can experience significant distress regarding change. Even when the transition or change is viewed as a positive change, like graduating, launching into a new realm of your career, moving or starting a new job there is a chance that these transitions could bring about fear and a fear response.

Fear is the ultimate primal brain response. Our brains are hardwired to make us check ourselves when fear is triggered. For some this initiates a flight response, for others it's a fight response. These are the two responses most people know. There are two others. Freeze and Fawn. Freezers are people who turn into blocks of ice in fear, they typically feel paralyzed by fear and feel as though they can't move. Fawners are the people pleasers. These individuals will do everything in their power to make those around them happy to address the fear, even if it does nothing for them in the long run.

Knowing our fear responses can help us all manage how we approach change and transition. For those freezers, knowing that if we take it on in little chunks vs all at once we can fight our own tendencies for freezing by reducing the opportunity for overwhelm. For those fighters, recognizing that when you feel pushed, giving yourself the opportunity for space and quiet to address how you are feeling and reduce the overwhelm. For those flighters, noticing that your tendency to run is directly related to feeling overwhelmed. Therefore, similar to freezers, taking things in smaller chunks to make it easier to navigate will work well. Lastly, the fawners. Coming to terms with the fear you are feeling is about you, and therefore it will not matter how many others around you that you keep happy or how you alter your approach to the situation for them unless you address how the situation is impacting you, nothing will change. Being able to identify your fear response and how to address it is a powerful tool to help us all move forward through change and transition.



Summary of the AVMA House of Delegates Winter Meeting

The AVMA House of Delegates (HOD) met on January 5-7 for the regular winter session in Chicago, IL. Several updates were provided by AVMA staff to the HOD regarding veterinary economics and workplace workforce issues. Several policies were up for their 5-year review. Many of them were germane to the practice of veterinary medicine and therefore brought forward to the HOD for discussion. During the economic update, information was provided regarding the suspected upcoming recession. The recession is predicted to be uneven and without a general downturn. All types of pet ownership is being affected by the impending recession. The number of household pets increased during spring of 2020 and 2021, but by the spring of 2022 there was a decrease in the number of households owning pets.

Inflation has taken a toll on everyone. Historical salary trends have been positive, especially in the last 5 years, but the reality is that even with all of the growth experienced, inflation continues to take a bite out of the earnings and has decreased disposable income. Inflation will drop during the economic downturn, but not significantly.

Retention and attrition of the veterinary care team continues to be a priority for the profession. We have seen a slight decline in the number of veterinarians considering leaving the profession, but we still have a problem with retention in practice as well as the profession itself. AVMA has created many workforce initiatives to help target where our challenges are and how we can tackle them. Some of these initiatives include:

<u>Surveys</u>: Help AVMA dig down at the state level with research-backed insights by responding to surveys that are distributed. Please take time to fill out these surveys.

Economic State of the Profession: Download and review the economic state of the veterinary profession report. With the accelerating-and at times tremendous-pace of change in both the veterinary profession and society at large, the need has never been greater for a resource to help veterinary decision-makers chart a course for the coming year and beyond. This latest report provides a detailed visual summary of the economic state of the veterinary profession and examines the major trends through the lens of veterinary education, veterinary employment, and veterinary services.

The Practice Pulse: This tool is a real-time monthly digest of key practice data, trends, and expert insights to bolster your business strategy and help your veterinary practice stay competitive. Practice Pulse leverages benchmarked data from thousands of veterinary practices, through a partnership between AVMA and VetSuccess.

Language of Veterinary Care Initiative: Fundamentally shifting how we communicate about veterinary care can make a big difference. The Language of Veterinary Care Initiative are tools that AVMA has created that can help veterinary teams integrate key words and phrases into daily conversations with clients. The goal is to help staff build critically important relationships with clients by fine tuning various conversations such as cost of care.

Organizational Interventions to Burnout: This is a study performed by Cornell and is funded by AVMA and the Zoetis Foundation. The purpose of this study is to identify and test strategies that can be used to reduce the rate of burnout among veterinarians through organizational trainings.

There were 5 AVMA facilitated veterinary roundtables in 2022 that involved 20 organizations and 25 key individuals from those organizations. AVMA found there was much willingness to have conversations and eagerness to work collaboratively regarding nuances in various sectors (emergency and critical care), retention and attrition in our profession, and how to leverage the team more effectively. Many conversations were around how we can use technicians appropriately and take the small steps to cross the bridge with our team, as well as how can we use systems and processes to improve efficiency.

DEI JOURNEY FOR TEAMS

Journey for Teams provides a learning pathway for vet professionals to deepen their knowledge of diversity and improve DEI in work places. The platform is designed for busy professionals to enhance and nurture their work experience and build meaningful relationships with clients and community. The goal is to expose, encourage, engage, inspire, and motivate your team. The program can be accessed at journeyforteams.org. There is a 15 minute welcome webinar, that once completed, you can advance to the educational models. A cornerstone guide is the navigator handbook which helps to lead staff meetings and facilitate discussions.

MARKETING UPDATE

The AVMA marketing team is committed to supporting the veterinary community. They have created a reputation management toolkit with an educational grant from Banfield. The toolkit is online and provides new tools to address these situations. A new benefit is that this is now available to all veterinary team members, not just AVMA members. AVMA has created a list of shared responsibilities on a poster that you can share in your workplace to help manage expectations. Find more information at avma.org/reputationmanagement.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The AVMA is financially secure with a \$1.57M projected operational net income and a \$9.8M projected investment revenue. The year 2022 brough about a persistent pandemic, a bear market, and continued threat of recession leading to a decreased bottom line. AVMA reserves maintain 100% of operations, and it's because of this fiscal responsibility that has allowed AVMA to continue to fully serve members and pursue initiatives amid the wild market. AVMA continues to deliver member value and maintain member satisfaction, advance advocacy and policy efforts, use data-informed strategies and tools to support the veterinary workforce, execute the DEI inclusion roadmap, and expand non-dues revenue strategies.

Increase in Grants and Incentives for Solar Systems for Rural Vet Clinics

The Federal Government will now cover 70-80% of a Solar System and battery backup! The USDA just released their new REAP grant guidelines: Total grant funding has <u>quadrupled</u> and the amount available per project has nearly doubled.

According to Rolf Scholtz from <u>All Energy Solar</u>, an MVMA Annual Meeting exhibitor, the new REAP grant covers up to 40% of the solar project as long as it's in a rural area or is an actual farm. The tax credit has also been raised to 30% of the overall project which means the Feds will pay 70% of your project. REAP grants and the tax credit also cover the cost of a backup battery so you'll never be caught in the dark during surgery.

The first deadline for application is March 31st. With the quick deadline, there will probably be more funds than applications which means nimble clinic owners working with a responsive solar installer may get a fantastic deal. Some solar installers have experience writing or connecting you to REAP grants and will work with clinics on getting a strong application submitted.

2023 Certification for Veterinary Technicians

Certification renewals for 2023 started January 1st, 2023. Submitting renewals now will ensure timely processing so please remind your technician to submit their certification renewal now!

*New starting with 2023 renewals!! We will no longer be issuing a CVT card. However, if someone still wants to receive a card, there will be a \$5 additional fee which a CVT can choose when they fill out their certification report form either online or mail-in. CVT cards can be accessed digitally on their profile page: https://mvma.memberclicks.net/cvt-landing-page.

Normal timeframe for processing certification renewals is 6-8 weeks; however, this timeframe greatly increases closer to the expiration date of renewals which is June 30th, 2023. The MVMA will be offering an expediting fee of \$100 which can be selected when renewing online only. Turnaround time for expedited renewals will be 5-7 business days.

Getting to the Bottom of the Veterinary Technician Shortage in Minnesota

"Proposed Changes to the Minnesota Veterinary Practice Act"

In this article, #16 in the series, we share an update of where we are during the 2023 legislative session. The bill was introduced in the House of Representatives (HF 1228) on February 2, 2023 and in the Senate (SF 1522) on February 9, 2023. Both bills have bipartisan support and authors. We hope and anticipate getting a hearing in the House and then the Senate. We are cautiously optimistic that the bill has a chance this year. We have met with numerous legislators to inform them of the need to license veterinary technicians NOW! We are looking forward to participation from both veterinarians and technicians for Veterinary Day at the Capitol on March 8, 2023.

One of the major goals of the LVT initiative is to assist with retaining veterinary technicians in the profession. When we talk with legislators, our focus is different though. They are concerned about public safety including drug diversion by unlicensed individuals. Legislators also seem interested in the looming veterinary shortage and how licensure of technicians may alleviate the shortage. They also ask about costs, and we have shared that the cost of certification versus licensure will be very similar, and licensed veterinary technicians will not need to purchase personal liability insurance, as they are still taking direction from a licensed veterinarian.

Another strategy has been to get the public informed and possibly involved in support of the legislation. Here are key points about licensure for the public to know:

- -one of only 8 States that doesn't regulate technicians
- -provides assurance to the public of qualified and competent veterinary care
- -State accountability and oversight of their actions
- -recognizes the investment of taxpayers in technician education from State colleges (only four veterinary technician programs in MN and all are State colleges)
- -leads to retention of technicians in the career field, which may help with the looming shortage of veterinarians

The following (to the right) shows the the Key Components of the Bill directly from the MVMA website:

- Certified veterinary technicians currently in good standing with the MVMA are immediately eligible for licensure.
- Non-certified veterinary technicians would be eligible to apply if they are currently practicing, performed 4160 hours of experience (within the previous 5 years), and have a letter of recommendation from a licensed veterinarian stating their competency.
- With regulated credentialing, Licensed Veterinary Technicians (LVTs) will aid in the purpose to protect the health and safety of the public and animal patients in the state of Minnesota.
 - Properly trained veterinary team members impact many areas including: infectious diseases; zoonotic diseases; ensuring food and feed safety; animal control and injury protection.
 - Properly trained veterinary team members ensure functional health in companion animals, service and working animals, as well as livestock and research animals.
- Upon licensure, the role of veterinary technicians in patient care will be better defined while remaining under the supervision of a licensed veterinarian.
- With licensure, veterinary technicians will be able to provide direct supervision to veterinary assistants and other unlicensed employees of tasks delegated by the licensed veterinarian. We have also added a clause to allow for remote supervision of technicians by the DVM.
- Veterinary team members not eligible for licensure or choosing not to be licensed will be called veterinary assistants.
- Licensure also ensures veterinary technicians are familiar with and understand the state's laws and regulations governing their profession.
- MN Board of Veterinary Medicine shall oversee and establish licensure requirements.

Practice Act changes will strengthen veterinary education

Minnesota's Veterinary Practice Act (VPA) is written to ensure only qualified individuals are allowed to practice veterinary medicine in the state. However, the current language prevents highly qualified individuals, trained outside of the US, from working at the College of Veterinary Medicine, a real disadvantage for our state. The unprecedented and growing shortage of clinical faculty adds urgency to the need for changes to Minnesota's VPA.

"The shortage of clinical faculty isn't just a Minnesota problem," says Dean Laura Molgaard, DVM. "I recently moderated a national session on the topic, which illustrates the widespread interest. Unfortunately, our VPA is more restrictive than those in several other states. Several key programs in our college, such as medical imaging and surgery, are at a serious recruiting disadvantage due to the VPA."

Minnesota's current VPA restricts licensure to graduates of AVMA accredited veterinary schools, an easy to measure and reasonable standard. However, this restriction eliminates the best and brightest from veterinary schools around the world–those who have passed the rigorous process of selection for advanced training programs. Leaders from the College and the MVMA are working to provide an institutional license for qualified individuals from non-accredited schools while they work at the College to help train DVM students or to acquire advanced training through a residency or internship. A number of safeguards would remain in place to ensure that the highest standards are maintained.

The proposed changes would create an institutional license for clinicians while they work at the College. Among other requirements, applicants would need to pass the Minnesota Veterinary Jurisprudence exam, provide multiple letters of recommendation, and participate in the regular peer reviews that are required of all clinicians. Interns and residents work under the supervision of specialists, a high standard. The institutional license would be available to all University programs that hire veterinarians. The proposed VPA language emulates that of other states that are having increased success in recruiting qualified faculty, interns, and residents from international colleges of veterinary medicine.

"The shortage is a complex and multifaceted challenge," Molgaard says, "but changing Minnesota's VPA is one barrier we can eliminate." Legislation has been introduced in the MN House and was awaiting a hearing as this issue of the MVMA newsletter went to press.

High Blood Pressure: Understanding the brain's role

According to the CDC, nearly half of U.S. adults have high blood pressure, which is a major contributing factor to life-threatening health conditions like heart attack and stroke. A veterinary research team led by

Dr. John Collister found that the median preoptic nucleus (MnPO), a cluster of nerves in the hypothalamus, helps direct the body's blood pressure. Deciphering which parts of the brain regulate the body's blood pressure could help scientists pin down more effective, lasting treatments for this widespread issue.

The team is building on this work to investigate whether changes in the gut microbiome influence the blood pressure in animals with and without an impaired MnPO. This may lead to an ability to target future antibiotic and pro or prebiotic treatments for hypertension.

New model helps DVMs predict the risk of PRRS outbreaks in pigs



Like other viruses such as influenza and SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS) in pigs evolves to evade the immune response. So, while a vaccine may provide protection against some strains, new strains may not be effectively neutralized. Accurately predicting whether a herd is or is not protected is important information for a veterinarian to know.

The UM veterinary team, led by Drs. Kim VanderWaal and Dennis Makau, used routinely collected data from genetic sequencing of the PRRSv to examine how specific genetic differences between strains contributed to different immune responses in infected animals. Using

these data, they developed an algorithm to estimate if a pig's existing immunity will be adequate to neutralize a new strain. Their model was able to estimate this cross-protection with 81% accuracy. The team is working to adapt the model for sequences of PRRS Type 2—the dominant type found in U.S. swine herds.




