



MVMA/MVMF SDSU Student Representative Job Description

The role of the MVMA/MVMF student representative is to act as a liaison between these organizations and SDSU's PPVM student body. The student representative activities include promotion of membership to the student body throughout the year, disseminating information from the MVMA/MVMF to the student body in a timely manner, helping to schedule lunch meetings with student body and to generally act as a point of contact between the MVMA and PPVM students. The student representative is also expected to attend bimonthly SAVMA meetings. Methods of communication will be verbal, email, and very importantly, using social media. Major events for student representative include the MVMA annual conference, and involvement on the Path to Practice task force (CVM), MVMA/MVMF board reports, MVMA State Fair exhibits volunteer recruitment, MVMF fundraising and scholarship advertising, volunteer activities including the golf and clay shooting events, and other student-oriented projects as they present themselves.

There will be at least quarterly meetings with the MVMA Executive Director, staff liaison, and other representatives if applicable and the position will be paid a \$500 stipend near the beginning of each semester.
