



MVMA/MVMF Student Representative Job Description



The role of the MVMA/MVMF student representative is to act as a liaison between these organizations and the U of M College of Veterinary Medicine's student body. The student rep. activities include promotion of membership to the student body throughout the year, to disseminate information from the MVMA/MVMF to the student body in a timely manner, and generally act as a point of contact between the organizations. Methods for communication will be verbal, email, and very importantly, using social media. Major events for student rep. involvement include the MVMA annual convention, MVMA member annual dues mailing, committee involvement on CVM Liaison committee, MVMA/MVMF board reports, State fair exhibits and volunteer recruitment, MVMF fundraising and scholarship advertising, volunteer activities including the golf and clay shooting events, and other student oriented projects as they present themselves. There will be quarterly meetings with the MVMA Executive Director and the position will be paid at the beginning of each semester. The student representative is also expected to attend bimonthly SCAVMA meetings and be an MVMA member.
